INTRODUCTION TO THE DofE COURSE

1. An Introduction to the DofE (IdofE) course will take place on 5th March at RAF St.Mawgan. The aim of the course is to provide an understanding of the mission and guiding principles of the DofE; its benefits to young people, the DofE programme and guidance on how to run the DofE in a Squadron, and includes an introduction to eDofE.
2. The course is aimed at Staff and senior cadets (must be over 16) who have not previously been involved and wish to run or help with the DofE. It will also serve as a useful refresher for those who have not been involved in the DofE for some time, as there have been many changes over the last few years.
3. Those attending **must** have undertaken the e-Induction on-line module, which is a pre-requisite for attendance on the IdofE course. The module is available through the DofE web site and can be accessed from the link below. There is a letter which can be printed out as evidence of having completed e-induction. This must be brought to the course.
